

1. **PGT (Physical Education)**

(a) **Mandatory Qualification:** Post graduate or equivalent degree in Physical Education from a recognized university with minimum 50% marks in aggregate.

(b) **Desirable Qualification:**

- (i) Knowledge of Computer application.
- (ii) Ability to read/ write/ communicate in Hindi & English
- (iii) CTET/ STET qualified candidates will be given additional weightage during selection.
- (iv) Experience of working as Physical Education Teacher in a recognized higher Secondary school or intermediate college.

(c) **Age Limit:** Should be in the age group of 21 to 50 years as on 01 Jul of the academic year in which the post is being filled.

2. **TGT (Mathematics)**

(a) **Mandatory Qualification:** A Masters or a Bachelor's Degree from any University recognised by the Govt of India/ UGC/ AICTE with a minimum marks of 50 percent in the subject and 50 percent in the aggregate, including electives and languages, in the combination of subjects as Maths with any two out of Physics, Chemistry, Electronics, Computer Science or Statistics.

(i) A Bachelor of Education Degree or its equivalent from a college/ university recognised by Govt of India/AICTE/UGC/National Council of Teachers Education.

(ii) Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years.

(iii) Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected

for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.

(iv) Candidates with at least two years continuous service as a PGT/TGT or three years as a PRT/NTT in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School.

(v) Should be able to read, write and communicate fluently in English.

(b) Desirable Qualifications (Due weightage to be given during selection)

(i) Knowledge of computer applications, especially MS Office.

(ii) Ability to read/write/communicate in Hindi.

(iii) CTET/STET qualified candidates will be given additional weightage during selection.

Age Limit: Should be in the age group of 21 to 50 years as on 01 Jul of the academic year in which the post is being filled.

3. TGT (Science)

(a) Mandatory Qualification: A Masters or a Bachelor's Degree from any University recognised by the Govt of India/ UGC/ AICTE with a minimum marks of 50 percent in the subject and 50 percent in the aggregate, including electives and languages, in the combination of subjects as Botany, Zoology and Chemistry (All three subjects should have been studied).

(i) A Bachelor of Education Degree or its equivalent from a college/ university recognised by Govt of India/AICTE/UGC/National Council of Teachers Education.

(ii) Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years.

(iii) Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.

(iv) Candidates with at least two years continuous service as a PGT/TGT or three years as a PRT/NTT in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School.
